**Approval of August 29, 2019 Wildlife Resources Commission (WRC) Meeting Minutes** – the Commission approved the August 29, 2019 WRC minutes as written in the exhibit and distributed to members (**Exhibit A**).

**Approval of September 12, 2019 WRC Telephonic Meeting Minutes** – the Commission approved the September 12, 2019 WRC telephonic meeting minutes as written in the exhibit and distributed to members (**Exhibit B**).

**Lawrence G. Diedrick Small Game Award** – on a motion from the Small Game and Wild Turkey Committee, the Commission voted for the recipient of the 2019 Lawrence G. Diedrick Small Game Award.

**Rulemaking - 2020-2021 Game Land Rule Proposals** – the Commission approved staff recommendations for proposed changes in 2020-2021 game land rules to be presented at statewide public hearings (**Exhibit D-1**) and approved the Fiscal Note for proposed changes in the 2020-2021 game land rules (**Exhibit D-2**).

**Phase II Land Acquisitions** – the Commission approved proceeding with acquisitions by donations of the McDowell Shooting Range Tract in McDowell County and the Lahuis Tract in Henderson County (**Exhibits E-1, E-2**).

**Exhibit F**, the disposition of the Gibson Fox Trial Facility in Scotland County, was removed from the agenda.

**Rulemaking – 2020-2021 Fishing Rule Proposals** – the Commission approved staff recommendations for proposed changes in 2020-2021 fishing rules to be presented at statewide public hearings (**Exhibit G-1**) and approved the Fiscal Note for proposed changes in the 2020-2021 fishing rules (**Exhibit G-2**).

**Rulemaking – 2020-2021 Wildlife Management Rule Proposals** – the Commission approved staff recommendations for proposed changes in 2020-2021 wildlife management rules to be presented at statewide public hearings (**Exhibit H-1**) and approved the Fiscal Note for proposed changes in the 2020-2021 wildlife management rules (**Exhibit H-2**).

**Temporary Rulemaking Adoption – Wildlife Reserve 15A NCAC 10L .0101** – the Commission adopted a temporary rule addressing the activities required for land to qualify for present-use value taxation as wildlife conservation land that creates and is actively and regularly used as a reserve for hunting, fishing, shooting, wildlife observation or wildlife activities (**Exhibit I**).

**Temporary Rulemaking Adoption – License Fees 15A NCAC 10A .1601** – the Commission adopted a temporary rule moving all licenses, permits, stamps and certifications issued and administered by the Commission and associated fees from statute to rule and adjusting existing fees by the CPI-U (**Exhibit J-2**).

**Approval of 2020 Wildlife Resources Commission Meetings Schedule** – the Commission adopted the schedule of 2020 meetings of the Wildlife Resources Commission (**Exhibit K**).
