Becoming an Outdoors-Woman (BOW) is an international program that is sponsored in North Carolina by the N.C. Wildlife Resources Commission. Taught by experienced instructors, the program is designed for women ages 18 and older. Participants learn skills through guided hands-on experiences in the outdoors.

N.C. BOW offers an annual three-day workshop, and several Beyond BOW workshops are held across the state. BOW events focus on single topics such as hunting, archery and fly-fishing. Participant skill levels may range from beginner to advanced.

WOMEN'S DEER HUNT NORTHAMPTON COUNTY

Have you ever wanted to go on a deer hunt but lacked the right opportunity? The Beyond BOW, Women's Deer Hunt is the opportunity you've been looking for. Designed for new or novice women hunters, this hunting experience provides participants with an evening introduction to responsible hunting and one-on-one guidance during the Saturday hunt.

Participants will learn about hunter safety, ethics of hunting, deer biology, deer herd management, shot placement and more. Experienced staff and volunteers conduct the Friday evening orientation and guide participants with the hunt and harvest on Saturday. This is a limited hunt—to achieve wildlife management objectives, we limit the number of hunters, and harvest limited to does only.

You only need to have a hunting license and a willingness to learn. Lodging and meals are included in the registration fee. Beyond BOW events are sponsored by the N.C. Wildlife Resources Commission.

Who: Women age 18 and up who want to experience deer hunting
When: Oct. 23–24, 2009
Where: Bridger's Creek Hunting Lodge, near Rich Square in Northampton County
Cost: \$100 for one night (Friday) or \$135 for two nights (Friday & Saturday). Fee covers instruction, guide, lodging and meals as noted.

space limited ~ first come, first served

Accommodations Small hunting lodge with single beds. You will need to bring your own bedding and linens. Friday check-in is 3:30–5:00 p.m.

Meals include supper on Friday, breakfast and lunch on Saturday, plus continental breakfast on Sunday for Saturday night lodgers. Snacks and drinks will be provided as well as coffee and ice water. You may bring your own snacks and drinks.

Directions will be sent with your confirmation packet. The hunting property is located near Rich Square in Northampton County.

Packing Hunting license; warm, layered clothing, including thick socks, blaze orange cap or garment; rain gear; linens and bedding; toilet articles; narrow rope or cording for tow line; legal firearm and ammunition; camping type seat or folding chair for box stand; whistle; strong flashlight; ice chest; ice; plastic garbage and zip-lock bags or other packaging to transport your harvest home.

Optional: Camouflage hunting clothes, cover scent, sharp knives for skinning and cutting, knife sharpener, camera.

Don't forget your hunting license!
