

The Pisgah Center for Wildlife Education Directions and Map

The center is easily accessible off U.S. Highway 276 near Pisgah Forest, North Carolina, in Transylvania County.

From I-40

- Take exit 46A off I-40 (I-26 East, Hendersonville exit)
- From I-26E take exit #40 (Asheville Airport & Brevard)
- Turn right at end of exit ramp onto highway 280 West
- Once on Hwy 280 drive approximately 17 miles
- At the traffic light in Pisgah Forest (Bi-Lo, Taco Bell, Wal-Mart), Hwy 280 will intersect with Hwy 276 & Hwy 64
- At this intersection turn right onto Hwy 276 North
- Drive approximately 5.5 miles (Just after a bridge)
- There will be a fork in the road and a sign for the Pisgah Center for Wildlife Education
- Bear to the left onto Forest Service Road 475
- Drive approximately 1.5 miles and turn left at the Pisgah Center for Wildlife Education sign.

From I-26

- Take exit #40 (Asheville Airport & Brevard)
- Turn at end of exit ramp onto Highway 280 West towards Brevard
- Once on Hwy 280 drive approximately 17 miles
- At the traffic light in Pisgah Forest (Bi-Lo, Taco Bell, Wal-Mart), Hwy 280 will intersect with Hwy 276 & Hwy 64
- At this intersection turn right onto Hwy 276 North
- Drive approximately 5.5 miles on Hwy 276 (Just after a bridge)
- There will be a fork in the road and a sign for the Pisgah Center for Wildlife Education
- Bear to the left onto Forest Service Road 475
- Drive approximately 1.5 miles and turn left at the Pisgah Center for Wildlife Education sign.

From Brevard College

- Take a right out of the college gate onto Hwy 64
- Drive approximately 3 miles to the intersection of Hwy 276 & Hwy 280
- At this intersection turn left onto Hwy 276 North
- Drive approximately 5.5 miles (Just after a bridge)
- There will be a fork in the road and a sign for the Pisgah Center for Wildlife Education
- Bear to the left onto Forest Service Road 475
- Drive approximately 1.5 miles and turn left at the Pisgah Center for Wildlife Education sign.
