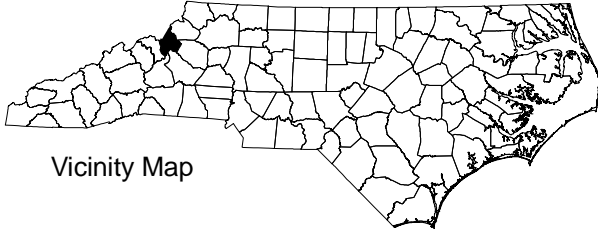


Avery County, North Carolina

Trout Stream Regulations



Angling opportunities exist on waters managed by the Blue Ridge Parkway. Although the National Park Service establishes fishing regulations for parkway waters, the North Carolina Wildlife Resources Commission aids with fisheries management by stocking catchable-size trout into Linville River, Avery County. All persons age 16 or older must possess a valid North Carolina or Virginia fishing license to fish parkway waters; please contact the Blue Ridge Parkway (828-271-4779, Ext. 200) for information regarding fishing on parkway waters.
