North Carolina's wildlife needs your donation!

Donations to the Nongame and Endangered Wildlife Fund enable the N.C. Wildlife Resources Commission to conserve hundreds of species and their habitats for future generations of North Carolinians to enjoy and appreciate.

The Fund receives donations primarily through two sources: your North Carolina State tax returns and the Wildlife Conservation License Plate. Your donation to the Nongame and Endangered Wildlife Fund goes entirely to projects that support the conservation and management of nongame animals, like songbirds, turtles, bats, and many others.
