- Hunters under the age of 16 must have successfully passed a State-approved hunter education course and provide proof of certification (card or certificate) upon request, and must be directly supervised by an adult 21 years of age or older.

**Other Information:**

- Authorizes hunting only in the Northeast Hunt Zone during the open season. Refer to the Regulations Digest for a map and description of the counties included within this hunt zone.
- Youth less than 18 years of age who purchase a Northeast Hunt Zone Canada goose permit prior to the season closing may use that permit on youth waterfowl days. Permits will not be available for purchase after the close of the regular season. In addition to the permit, those ages 16 and 17 hunting on youth waterfowl days must possess the appropriate valid hunting and privilege licenses, federal duck stamp, and HIP certification.
