Wild Quail Management Area Agreement



When signed by the qualifying landowner(s) and an authorized representative of the North Carolina Wildlife Resources Commission (NCWRC), this agreement along with supporting documentation as required by the NCWRC shall designate the properties identified in this agreement as a Wild Quail Management Area (WQMA) pursuant to 15A NCAC 10B .0227.

This signed agreement between the landowner(s) and the NCWRC is accompanied by a copy of 15A NCAC 10B .0277, a signed WQMA Overview and Application, an Annual WQMA Report Form, and a 5-year management plan provided by the landowner(s) and approved by the NCWRC that includes but is not limited to:

- (1) a list of all owners of land included in the WQMA;
- (2) county parcel identification information for each parcel in the WQMA;
- (3) a scaled map of the WQMA with the areas to be maintained in year-round bobwhite quail habitat identified; and
- (4) management practices to be used to maintain bobwhite quail habitat and populations.

A representative of the NCWRC inspected the property and determined the land and habitat qualify to become a WQMA. This agreement and WQMA designation are valid for 5-years, and renewal is conditional upon another property inspection and renewed agreement with an accompanying updated 5-year management plan.

Failure of a landowner(s) to meet or comply with 15A NCAC 10B .0227, including annual reporting requirements, may result in denial of properties to be designated as WQMAs for the current or future years, whichever is applicable.
