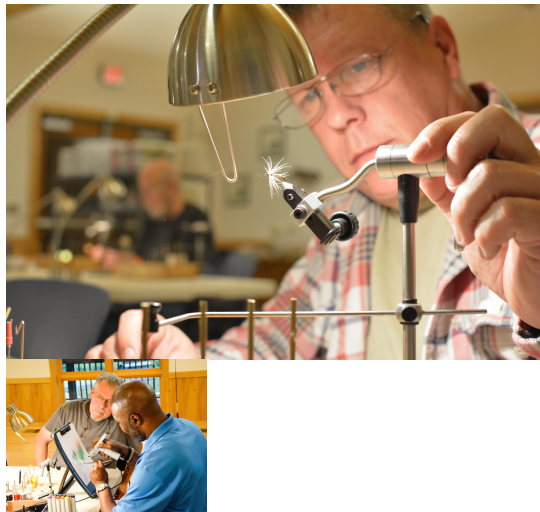


Virtual Fly-tying Forum April 22nd, 2021

This is our regularly scheduled online fly-tying program that takes place on the 4th Thursday of each month. The Fly-tying Forum provides tyers with an opportunity to increase their skills. Open to fly-tiers of all skill levels, the fly patterns change each month as a way to encourage learning various new tying techniques and development of tying skills. This month we will be tying two early season trout patterns, the march brown spider dry and wet fly. Participants registered for this program will be responsible for supplying their own materials, or picking them up at the Pechmann Center's drop box .

March Brown Spider

Hook: Size 12 standard dry fly hook

Thread: 8/0 uni, dark brown

Tail: CDL fibers

Body: Superfine dry fly dubbing, march brown

Hackle: Natural partridge, Brown rooster

March Brown Wet fly

Hook: Size 12 Mustad S60

Thread: 8/0 uni, dark brown

Tail: Mallard flank

Ribbing: Fine oval tinsel, gold

Body: Hares ear dubbing

Hackle: Natural partridge

Wing: Mottled turkey
