

Kayak Fishing Workshop -July 10th, 2021

This free workshop is designed to give anglers and paddlers the information and skills required to safely and successfully fish in sheltered waters from a kayak. This program begins with a classroom seminar covering equipment and safety, then we move to Lake Rim for instruction in basic kayak operation and fishing. All equipment and tackle is provided.

Participants will learn the basics of kayak fishing including: choosing a boat, required equipment, outfitting and rigging, tackle/gear selection and safety.

A valid NC fishing license is required.

This workshop is suitable for participants 14 years old and older. Children 14 and 15 must be accompanied by an adult. No prerequisite. Each workshop is limited to the first 11 people, and pre-registration is required.
