Discussion - Restricted Deer Hunting Zone on Bladen Lakes Game Land

Isaac Harrold reported that the public hearing for a proposed restricted deer hunting zone on Bladen Lakes State Forest Game Land was held on July 8, 2014. Two attendees supported the proposed zone and 18 opposed it. The Bladen County Board of Education supports the restricted zone because of the location of the school. The Committee will recommend a proposal for three tracts on Bladen Lakes Game Land for possible action at the WRC meeting on August 28, 2014.

Initial Review of Proposed Rules for 2015-2016

Dr. David Cobb presented an initial review of 2015-2016 proposed wildlife management rules for consideration by the Commission at a later meeting. Bob Curry presented thirty-four proposals for fisheries to be considered at a later meeting.

Temporary Rulemaking for Captive Cervids

The Committee discussed recent legislation by the General Assembly pertaining to cervid farming in North Carolina. Temporary rules must be promulgated to comply with the legislation. Two public hearings will be held to hear concerns and discuss objectives. On October 7 a hearing will be held in Statesville and on October 14 a hearing will be held in Raleigh.

Depredation Permit Conditions Allowing Retention of Edible Portions

The Committee discussed depredation permit conditions allowing retention of edible portions of animals other than cervids.

<u>Resolution</u>

Dr. Cobb presented a resolution regarding the use of processed food products. The Commission voted to adopt the resolution and to incorporate the resolution into the minutes of this meeting.

Other Discussion

Jett Ferebee, who owns property in the area of the Red Wolf Reintroduction Area, send a FOIA request to the USFWS and discovered that 64 red wolves were released by the USFWS onto private land, which Ferebee stated is illegal. Ferebee requested assistance from the WRC and stated that 300 landowners in that area have requested removal of the wolves from private property. Director Gordon Myers stated that a consultation will be held with the Attorney General for a legal opinion.

At 5:55 pm the COW moved into closed session to discuss a legal matter.

At 6:28 pm the COW returned to open session and adjourned the meeting.
