

RWB-CASWELL GAME LAND SHOOTING RANGE

GENERAL RANGE RULES

- Use of the range is allowed only during the hours of operation posted on site. Range use occurring after posted hours of operation will be considered as trespassing and violators will be prosecuted.
- Hearing and eye protection MUST be used at all times by shooters AND spectators.
- Shooters and Visitors may NOT be under the influence of or in possession of alcoholic beverages or other controlled substances.
- All firearms MUST be unloaded and properly holstered or cased when entering or leaving the ranges. Firearms may not be loaded until on the designated firing line.
- Only paper targets and approved target stands are allowed and must be placed above ground level.
- No tracer or incendiary ammunition may be fired on ranges.
- Shooting in the prone position is prohibited.
- It is unlawful to shoot at any airborne targets including skeet and trap.
- It is unlawful to use archery equipment at this site.
- NO .50 caliber Browning Machine Gun (BMG) or larger caliber firearms allowed.
- It is unlawful to discharge a weapon from any location other than the designated firing line and/or bench rests.
- All firearms will be unloaded and actions open while targets are being hung and or checked. **Do not handle firearms while someone is down range!**
- Stand behind the bench rest or firing line while targets are being hung or checked.
- No person under the age of 16 may shoot unless accompanied by an Adult (age 21 or older) who is responsible for their actions.
- Shoot only at the target in front of your lane; cross lane firing is prohibited.
- Do not run on range and keep off berms.
- Do not sit or climb on top of bench rests or tables.
- Smoking on the firing line is prohibited.
- Pets or equine species are not allowed at the range.
- Remove all targets from the range and clean up your area, including brass, after you have finished shooting.
- **Remember the Basics of Firearms Safety:**
 1. **Control your muzzle: Keep your firearm pointed in a safe direction.**
 2. **Treat every firearm as if it were loaded.**
 3. **Be sure of your target and what is beyond it.**
 4. **Keep your finger off the trigger and outside of the trigger guard until you are ready to shoot.**
