Reception & Reservations

Volunteers welcome visitors and orient them to the layout of the Wildlife Center. They also assist in answering phone calls and making reservations for upcoming programs. This position can serve in conjunction with the Wild Store duties if the volunteer is comfortable doing so.

Wild Store Assistant

Volunteers assist with sales, inventory, and stocking of the NC Wild Store located in the lobby of the Wildlife Center. This position can serve in conjunction with Reception & Reservation duties if the volunteer is comfortable doing so.

Wildlife Discovery Cart Docent

Volunteers set-up education discovery stations in the building or on the grounds of the Wildlife Center and engage visitors in topics of coastal wildlife. Carts may contain games, artifacts, and other activities to help the docent facilitate conversation as visitors pass through. Docents may train on existing cart topics or work with education staff to create their own. This position can be broken down into shorter volunteer shifts or split with other volunteer areas if the volunteer is interested.

Landscaping and Groundskeeper

Volunteers assist with tasks such as weeding, watering, mulching, pruning and general upkeep of Wildlife Center grounds. Independent projects such as water or native plant gardens in line with the Center's mission may be possible based on the volunteer's interests. This position can be broken down into shorter volunteer shifts or split with other volunteer areas if the volunteer is interested.
