Other Information:

- Applicant must hold a valid N.C. hunting license and N.C. waterfowl privilege license on Oct. 1, 2018. The basic hunting license does not include the waterfowl privilege, it must be purchased separately. Those without these licenses and their party members will be disqualified from the drawing.
- A youth hunter less than 16 years of age on Oct. 1, 2018, who is not properly licensed, must apply for a Tundra Swan Permit as a member of a party with a properly licensed adult at least 18 years of age.
- Duplicate permit applications will result in disqualification of the applicant and all party members, if applicable.
- Those who failed to return the 2017-2018 tundra swan permit survey by the deadline will not be eligible for a permit in the 2018-2019 season and will be disqualified during the draw process.
