This license shall be issued only to an individual resident of North Carolina who is TOTALLY disabled as determined by the Social Security Administration (SSA), Civil Service Retirement System (CSRS), Railroad Retirement Board (RRB), or the N.C. State Retirement System (NCSRS) and remains valid for the lifetime of the individual so long as the individual remains totally disabled. Certification from one of these four agencies must be submitted with this application.

- Inland Fishing (basic) - Statewide inland fishing. Includes fishing in designated Public Mountain Trout Waters, fishing in trout waters on game lands, and fishing in joint waters. It does not include fishing in coastal waters. \$10
Coastal Recreational Fishing - Authorizes fishing in coastal and joint waters. It does not authorize fishing in inland waters. \$10

Lifetime Totally Disabled Hunting & Fishing Licenses

- Hunting/Inland Fishing Combo (basic) - Statewide basic hunting and inland fishing. Includes fishing in designated Public Mountain Trout Waters, fishing in trout waters on game lands, and fishing in joint waters. It does not include fishing in coastal waters. \$10
Sportsman - Statewide hunting and inland fishing. Includes hunting for big game, hunting on game lands, hunting for waterfowl (does not include the bear management e-stamp or federal duck stamp), fishing in designated Public Mountain Trout Waters, fishing in trout waters on game lands, and fishing in joint waters. It does not include fishing in coastal waters. \$100
Sportsman/Coastal Recreational Fishing - Statewide hunting, inland and coastal recreational fishing. Includes hunting for big game, hunting on game lands, hunting for waterfowl (does not include the bear management e-stamp or federal duck stamp), fishing in designated Public Mountain Trout Waters, fishing in trout waters on game lands, and fishing in joint waters. \$110
Bear Management E-Stamp - This electronic stamp is required to hunt bear. This e-stamp is available for purchase each year from July 1 to close of bear season. \$10
Federal Duck Stamp - This stamp is required for waterfowl hunters 16 years of age and older. This stamp expires June 30 of each year. \$26.50
