The Green River Game Land is a state-owned, 14,464-acre game land located in Henderson and Polk counties. The N.C. Wildlife Resources Commission actively manages the tract with prescribed fire to provide quality early successional habitat. This area is home to several of North Carolina's bird Species of Greatest Conservation Need. [Green River Game Land Birding Trail Map.](#)

Driving Directions: To the Big Hungry section: From I-26, take Exit 53 and head east on Upward Road for 1.5 miles. Turn right onto Big Hungry Road and follow it, making two more turns, for 5.3 miles to the Long Ridge Road parking area and gate, on the right. This parking area is 0.6 miles past the parking area with the kiosk and is just before Big Hungry Road dead ends.

\*Suggested bird walk: A 2.5 mile, clockwise loop over Long Ridge Road to Bear Branch, to Bishop Branch, and back to the parking lot on Big Hungry Road.

To the Green River Cove Road section: From I-26, take exit 59 (Saluda) and head east on Holbert Cove Road for 0.2 miles. Turn left onto Green River Cove Road and drive down through the switchbacks. To access the Walcott Tract, travel 3.6 miles on Green River Cove Road to the first bridge over the River and turn right behind Wilderness Cove Tube Shop. Follow dirt road back to game land parking area and gate. There are additional pull-offs farther down Green River Cove Road that also allow access to the Game Land property.

\*Suggested bird walk: A 2.5 mile roundtrip out-and-back along a dirt road through the Walcott Tract.
