Motion from the Habitat, Nongame & Endangered Species Committee – The Commission approved a motion to recognize Dr. Wilson Laney as the 2024 Thomas L. Quay Wildlife Diversity Award recipient.

Reciprocal Hunting License Fees for Non-residents – The Commission approved the resolution to allow changes in nonresident hunting license fees for neighboring states to establish parity, under the authority of NCGS 113-275(a1) (**EXHIBIT C**)

Nongame Wildlife Advisory Committee Appointments – The Commission reappointed J. Edward Corey III, North Carolina Division of Parks and Recreation; Jared Gray, North Carolina Department of Transportation; G. Lane Sauls, VHB, Inc.; Dustin Smith, North Carolina Zoo; and Bruce White, GFR Forestry Consultants, PLLC, to the Nongame Wildlife Advisory Committee (**EXHIBIT D**)

Phase II Land Acquisition – The Commission approved the acquisition of Rash Heirs – Ashe County (**EXHIBIT E**)

Other Property Matters – The Commission approved the Easement Request from Dominion Energy to purchase an easement through a portion of R. Wayne Bailey-Caswell Game Land in Caswell County (**EXHIBIT F-1**) and denied the Easement Request from Tyr Energy Development Renewables to purchase an easement through a portion of Bertie County Game Land in Bertie County (**EXHIBIT F-2**)

Species Conservation Plan – The Commission approved the final adoption of the Sea Turtles Conservation Plan (**EXHIBIT G**)
