INTRODUCTION

For jurisdictional purposes, the various water bodies of coastal North Carolina are designated as either Inland, Joint, or Coastal through agreements between the North Carolina Wildlife Resources Commission and the North Carolina Marine Fisheries Commission.

This guide to North Carolina's Coastal, Joint, and Inland fishing waters, listed by county, is intended to serve as a quick reference in determining the designations of these named water bodies.

Boundaries between Inland and Joint or Coastal waters are frequently marked with boundary signs, but this is not always the case. The exact location of the boundary lines between all of the Inland, Joint, and Coastal waters are defined by points of latitude and longitude in rules of the North Carolina Marine Fisheries Commission. A copy of these rules may be obtained by contacting the North Carolina Division of Marine Fisheries, P.O. Box 769, Morehead City, NC 28557, or by calling 1-800-682-2632.

The approximate locations of the boundary lines between Inland, Joint, and Coastal waters can be viewed on maps produced by the North Carolina Division of Marine Fisheries on their internet web site http://www.ncfisheries.net/. Note that all parts of the Atlantic Ocean within North Carolina's jurisdiction are designated as Coastal waters.

RECREATIONAL HOOK & LINE LICENSE REQUIREMENTS

It is the responsibility of the license buyer to know whether he/she will be fishing in Inland, Joint, or Coastal waters and what type of license will be needed to be in compliance with applicable statutes and rules.

- Persons who intend to fish with hook and line in <u>Inland waters</u> must purchase and possess an Inland Fishing License.
- Persons who intend to fish with hook and line in <u>Joint waters</u> must purchase and possess either an Inland Fishing License **or** a Coastal Recreational Fishing License.
- Persons who intend to fish with hook and line in <u>Coastal waters</u> must purchase and possess a Coastal Recreational Fishing License.
- Persons who intend to fish with hook and line in all waters of the State may purchase a Unified Inland/CRFL license.
